

## Reach Policy

The regulation (EG) no. 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) is an EU Chemical Regulation that entered into force on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2007. REACH is an abbreviation of Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. Its purpose is a strong protection level of human health and the environment.

As a downstream user, we are liable for information towards customers. We are not liable for the registration of substances.

Products that you purchase from Cressall Resistors by the definition of REACH do not have to be registered. Our pre-suppliers will register chemical substances contained in our products that may be subject to registration.

In our experience no materials from the REACH restrictions list, Art 67, Annex XVII (ECHA candidate list 16 July 2019 - 201 SVHCs) with >0.1 mass percent are included in our products or packages.

Should we become aware of any changes to this situation we will take steps to notify our customers and minimise disruption to continuity of supply.
